1. The College shall have to create and maintain the necessary infrastructure as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University and amended from time to time.
2. The institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring committee for the continuous monitoring and implementation of norms and standards of the University. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution by the University periodically as and when desired by the University.
3. The Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman/President shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the University/Bylaws of society/trust/competent authority.
4. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature for smooth conduct of courses, as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
5. Principal and Faculty shall be appointed by the institute according to the procedure (vide letter No. IKGPTU/Reg./1150 Dated 13.06.2016), qualifications, experience and applicable pay scales shall be as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University. The salary should be disbursed through bank on monthly basis.
6. The institute shall have to maintain faculty student ratio (FSR) and other facilities like laboratories, computers centre, library etc., as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
7. The Institution will have an independent building and facilities with a separate approach and shall have a separate Principal/Director/faculty and other facilities as per the applicable norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
8. The institute is not authorized to start new course/increase or decrease in sanctioned intake/ closure of course/college/discontinuation without prior approval of the University.
9. Colleges offering Agriculture Course are required to comply with norms of Punjab State Council of Agricultural Education/University.
10. The institute shall maintain the website of institute and display the details of courses offered department wise along with all requisite facilities and faculty.
11. Admissions shall be made according to regulations /directions and eligibility criteria notified by the Punjab Govt/AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.

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12. The tuition and other fees shall be charged from students as prescribed by the State Govt./University. The Institute shall be responsible for levy, payment and collection of taxes as may be applicable to Institute. The University shall at all times, have the right to recover from Institute all the dues on account of tuition and other fees as prescribed by the State Govt./University. Further, the Institute shall at all times be liable to make payment of such taxes (including but not limited to goods and service tax, as applicable from time to time) as may be levied and demanded by the University. There might be a situation that University adopts a particular tax position, however, in case such tax position is changed for any reason whatsoever as per the sole discretion of University, the Institute shall as and when demanded by University, be liable to indemnify the University to for an amount equivalent to tax implications of such changed tax position along with applicable interest and penalty (if any) to the University within the specified period. It is clarified herein that such indemnified amount may be demanded by University for the period prior to the present affiliation order(s) and for the period of this affiliation order at any time in future, without any prior consent of the Institute.
13. The Institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
14. The Institutions shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grant/assistance from the Central/State Govt. or any other funding agency.
15. The institution shall have to maintain the records and account books in the proper form, as per applicable norms and the same must be audited by Chartered Accountant which may be inspected any time by the University.
16. Special academic audit and surprise inspection of the institute can be conducted as and when desired by the University.
17. The institution can be visited at any time by an Officer or a committee appointed by the University to check the requisite facilities/conditions as laid down by the UGC/AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/University.
18. The institute cannot run any other course affiliated with any other university in the same building allocated to the courses affiliated with IKGPTU.
19. The University can disaffiliate the institute, if it fails to deposit the continuation of affiliation fee as per schedule & non submission of continuation application form annually and non-fulfillment of requisite facilities as per the applicable norms and non-compliance of directions issued by the University from time to time.





In exercise of the powers conferred upon by the Vice-Chancellor under Section 10(8) of the I.K.Gujral Punjab Technical University **Quest College of Science & Technology, Jhanjeri, Mohali, Punjab** is granted affiliation with I.K.Gujral Punjab Technical University on provisional basis, for a period of one year, for running the following courses with an intake as specified, for the session **2019-20**, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The institute is not authorized to start new course/increase or decrease in sanction intake/close a course without prior approval of the University;
2. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the university, from time to time;
3. The College shall create the necessary infrastructure as per the norms prescribed by the University/UGC/AICTE for running the above courses during the session 2019-20 and onwards.
4. All infrastructure, instructional, faculty and other facilities shall be provided as per the UGC/AICTE/University norms prescribed from time to time;
5. Teaching and other staff shall be Appointed by the institute according to the procedure; qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by the UGC/AICTE/University from time to time and subject experts and nominee of the Vice chancellor of the University shall be invited in the selections vide letter No. IKGPTU/Reg./1150 Dated 13.06.2016 issued by Registrar Office.
6. The institute shall display the information like curriculum vitae, photograph, pay-scale of all faculty and staff on the website of the institute.
7. The institute shall pay the salary of faculty and staff as per UGC/AICTE pay scale through banks via DBS only, failing which the University has power to put on hold the affiliation/ continuation of all such Colleges /institutes;
8. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Govt./University within the overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the University from time to time from students.
9. Admissions shall be made according to regulations /directions and eligibility criteria of the University;
10. The Institutions shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grant/assistance from the Central/State Govt. or any other funding agency;
11. The institution shall maintain the record and books of account in the proper form, as prescribed by the University;
12. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any competent authority and shall be open for inspection by the University or anybody authorized it;
13. Special audit and inspection of the institute can be conducted as and when desired by the University;
14. The institution shall furnish requisite returns of income tax etc as prescribed by the Punjab Govt. for ensuring maintenance of financial rules.;



15. The institution can be visited at any time by an Officer or a committee appointed by the University to review the progress made by the institution in fulfilling conditions as laid down by the UGC/AICTE/University.
16. The Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the University.
17. The Institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form;
18. The institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board for the continuous monitoring and implementation of norms and standards of the University. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution by the University periodically as desired by the University.
19. The Institution will have an independent building and facilities as per norms of the University with a separate approach and shall have a separate Principal/Director/faculty and other facilities.
20. The University can disaffiliate the institute, if it fails to deposit the continuation affiliation fee as per schedule & non submission of continuation application form annually.
21. University has right to close the college/course or reduce the number of sanctioned seats at any time based on the inspection-report carried by the University without any notice.
22. Colleges offering Agriculture Course are required to comply with norms of Punjab State Council of Agricultural Education.
